

Warm weather arrives in Greeley County

After receiving 3.24 inches of precipitation in March, the weather for the first week of April in Greeley County has been warm and dry. The Tribune weather station did not report any precipitation for the past week.

The National Weather Service precipitation maps for the past week showed most of the county with no precipitation. There was .01 - 0.10 inches in the far northwest sections of the county.

The temperature at the Tribune station reached a record high of 88° on April 4. It broke the old record of 86° set in 1932.

The high temperatures at the station started with a high of 86° on March 29, dropped to a high of 47° on March 30 before rising to the record 88° on Easter Sunday, April 4.

In the month of March the weather station received 3.24 inches of precipitation compared to a normal for the month of 1.01 inches. For the year-to-date the station has received 4.03 inches

of moisture, which is 1.78 inches above the normal of 2.25 inches.

The first quarter precipitation in the county should provide good planting conditions for the spring corn and milo crops.

The average soil temperatures for the past week in Greeley County were 50° on March 30, 48° on March 31, 49° on April 1, 50° on April 2, 52° on April 3, 54° on April 4, and 57° on April 5.

The average wind speed for the past week in Greeley County was 6.9 mph with highs of 36.6 mph on March 29, and 32.5 mph on April 4.

Kansas Crop Progress And Condition

MANHATTAN, Kan. April 5, 2021 - For the week ending April 4, 2021, there were 5.8 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 6% very short, 12% short, 77% adequate, and 5% surplus. Subsoil

moisture supplies rated 7% very short, 17% short, 72% adequate, and 4% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 4% very poor, 13% poor, 29% fair, 47% good, and 7% excellent. Winter wheat jointed was 10%, behind 18% last year and 22% for the five-year average.

Corn planted was 2%, near 1% last year and 3% average.
