

Fall Crops in Greeley County need rain

The Tribune weather station did not report any rain for the past week. The National Weather Service precipitation maps and the Internet Rain reports for Greeley County did show some scattered rain. The precipitation maps showed most of the county with 0.01 – 0.10 inches and with heavier amounts from .50 – 1.0 in the southwest and .25 – .50 in the southeast. On the Internet Rain reports Aeschliman at 8 south and 3 north reported .25 inches on Aug. 1 and Woelk at 7 west and 9 south reported 0.50 inches. Most of the reports from farmers are that the fall crops need a rain. At the station the yearly rainfall amounts are still 5.93 inches above normal, but for July the rainfall amounts were 2.76 inches compared to an

average for the month of 3.14. The high temperatures for the past week at the station were in the 80 and 90s with a high of 97° on Wednesday, July 28. The low for the week was 53° on Monday morning, Aug. 2. The average soil temperatures for the past week in Greeley County were 79° on July 27, 80° on July 28, 81° on July 29, 82° on July 30 and 31, 81° on Aug. 1, and 79° on Aug. 2. The average wind speed in Greeley County for the past week was 6.5 mph with a high of 27.9 mph on Wednesday, July 28. According to the National Agriculture Statistics Service, as of August 1, in the West Central District of Kansas 89% of the corn is silking, and 58% is in dough.

Kansas Crop Progress And Condition

August 2, 2021 - For the week ending August 1, 2021, there were 6.6 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 11% very short, 33% short, 54% adequate, and 2% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 9% very short, 31% short, 58% adequate, and 2% surplus.
Field Crops Report:
 Corn condition rated 2% very poor, 8% poor, 25% fair, 54% good, and 11% excellent. Corn silking was 88%, equal to both last year and the five-year average. Dough was 46%, behind 51% last year, but near 42% average. Dented was 4%, behind 10% last year, and near 8% average. Soybean condition rated 4% very poor, 6% poor, 31% fair, 53% good, and 6% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 71%, behind 77% last year, and near 72% average. Setting pods was 39%, behind 53% last year, but near 38% average. Sorghum condition rated 2% very poor, 5% poor, 27% fair, 60% good, and 6% excellent. Sorghum headed was 43%, near 41% last year, and ahead of 38% average. Coloring was 3%, equal to both last year and average. Cotton condition rated 0% very poor, 5% poor, 34% fair, 56% good, and 5% excellent. **Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 3% very poor, 13% poor, 32% fair, 48% good, and 4% excellent.
