## Weather in Greeley County is mild and dry

The weather in Greeley County this past week has been mild and dry. The Tribune weather station reported temperatures in the 90s for most to the week. The highs in the 90s dropped to a high of 82° on Friday, Aug. 13 but rose back to 91° and 93° on Saturday and Sunday.

The station reported 0.04 inches of rain at their Friday morning, Aug. 13 reading and a trace on Saturday. The 0.04 inches for the week brought the total for the first 16 days of August to 0.54 inches. For the year-to-date the station has received 18.42 inches of precipitation, which is 5.18 inches above normal.

The National Weather Service precipitation maps showed 0.1 to .25 inches for the week in the northern sections of the county and heavier amounts from .25 – 1.0 in the south.

Alan Schlegel, agronomist at the Southwest Research Extension Center remarked on Monday, “The fall crops

still look pretty good, but it would sure be nice to have a good rain.”

The average soil temperatures on the county for the past week were 77° on Aug. 10, 78° on Aug. 11, 80° on Aug. 12, 77° on Aug. 13, 76° on Aug. 14, 78° on Aug. 15, and 79° on Aug. 16.

The average wind speed for the past week in Greeley County was 6.0 mph with a high of 29.6 mph on Thursday, Aug 12.

According to the National Agriculture Statistics Service, as of August 15, in the West Central District of Kansas 99% of the corn is silking, 74% is in dough, and 17% is dented.

**Kansas Crop Progress And Condition**  
**MANHATTAN, Kan. August 16, 2021** - For the week ending August 15, 2021, there were 5.8 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 13%

very short, 33% short, 52% adequate, and 2% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 11% very short, 32% short, 55% adequate, and 2% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Corn condition rated 4% very poor, 10% poor, 24% fair, 52% good, and 10% excellent. Corn silking was 97%, near 98% for both last year and the five-year average. Dough was 74%, behind 79% last year, and near 76% average. Dented was 25%, behind 38% last year and 36% average.

Soybean condition rated 3% very poor, 7% poor, 28% fair, 55% good, and 7% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 85%, near 89% both last year and average. Setting pods was 60%, behind 72% last year and 66% average.

Sorghum condition rated 2% very poor, 6% poor, 30% fair, 56% good, and 6% excellent. Sorghum headed was 75%, near 77% last year and 73% average. Coloring was 15%, near 16% last year

and 14% average.

Cotton condition rated 0% very poor, 11% poor, 38% fair, 43% good, and 8% excellent. Cotton squaring was 97%, ahead of 92% last year and 90% average. Setting bolls was 79%, well ahead of 54% last year and 48% average. Bolls opening was 5%, near 3% last year and 2% average.

**Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 5% very poor, 13% poor, 33% fair, 46% good, and 3% excellent.
